

Neighbourhood Watch

Our village has two neighbourhood watch schemes in place, one for Hillside Avenue, and the second being Breezemount estate.

Our community policeteam recommend that each estate or area within the village should have its own scheme in operation, with links between the participating groups.

Kitty Williamson is the co-ordinator for Hillside Avenue, a group which has been in place for over 2 years. Cathy Armstrong has been recently appointed co-ordinator for Breezemount, which was granted the scheme in July 2008.

Although crime is not a major issue within our village, we would ask you to participate in your local scheme by continuing to be a good neighbour and watchful of other peoples property near your house, especially over the holiday periods.
